



REFORMING FIFA (1/2)

- Numerous allegations of corruption following the 2010 decision of the FIFA Executive Committee (in one session) to award the rights to hold the 2018 and 2022 FIFA World CupsTM to Russia and Qatar
- FIFA (then) President Blatter decided to install a group of experts to reform FIFA

REFORMING FIFA (2/2)

- In the wake of an avalanche and as part of his "roadmap" to reform the organization, FIFA (then)
 President Blatter initiated an Independent Governance Committee (IGC), headed by Professor
 Pieth
- In the IGC's final report, Pieth gave FIFA some credit for the introduction of a new independent Ethics Committee; he however recommended the structural division into an investigatory and an adjudicatory chamber
- Further recommendations included a central integrity check for all Executive Committee
 members and limitations to the terms of office

2012 CHAIRMEN CHAMBERS FIFA ETHICS COMMITTEE

Chairman Investigatory Chamber:

- Michael Garcia, former US attorney for the Southern District of New York (appointed in 2012)
- To investigate the chaotic and controversial bidding process for the 2018 and 2022
 FIFA World CupsTM
- ___ Since May 2015, **Dr. Cornel Borbely**, Chairman of the Investigatory Chamber

Chairman Adjudicatory Chamber:

Hans-Joachim Eckert, at that time still judge for economic crime at a Munich District

Independent Ethics Committee

- Proceedings regulated by the FIFA Code of Ethics (FCE)
- Focus on conduct that has little or no connection with action on the pitch (art. 1 FCE)
- Investigates and judges the conduct of individuals bound by the code while performing their duties, and even while not
 performing their duties in case of potentially serious damage to the integrity, image or reputation of FIFA. (art. 27 FCE)
- Members must fulfil independence criteria, as stipulated by the FIFA Governance Regulations
- Operates under confidentiality terms regulated by art. 36 FCE
- Decisions of the Ethics Committee may be taken to the Appeal Committee (art. 80 FCE)
- Appeal Committee decisions are subject to appeals lodged with CAS (art. 58 FIFA Statutes and art. 81 FCE)



May initiate preliminary investigations at its own discretion (art. 62.3 FCE) or upon receipt of a complaint (art. 61 FCE)


Free use of resources while performing investigative duties (art. 66.3 FCE)

May request that the adjudicatory chamber to take provisional measures (art. 83 FCE)

- ▼ Final report of investigation proceedings is submitted to adjudicatory
- chamber, with all facts, relevant evidence, mention of the possible rule violations
- ▼ and a recommendation for taking the appropriate measures (art. 68 FCE)

ART. 42 FIFA CODE OF ETHICS

- "General obligation to collaborate
- 1. At the request of the Ethics Committee, the persons bound by this Code are obliged to contribute to establishing the facts of the case and, especially, to provide written or oral information as witnesses. A failure to cooperate may lead to a sanction in accordance with this Code.
- 2. Witnesses are obliged to tell the absolute and whole truth and to answer the questions put to them to the best of their knowledge and judgement.
- 3. If the witnesses are dilatory in responding, the chairman of the appropriate chamber may, after warning them, impose further disciplinary measures on them."


WHAT HAPPENED THEN?

- US lawyers worked in FIFA/with FIFA for internal investigations
- Prosecutors of the Central Prosecution Office of Switzerland ("Bundesanwaltschaft") asked for more documents
- No exchange of documents between US-DOJ,
 Bundesanwaltschaft and the Ethics
 Committee
