EU exclusive competences

EU /MS shared competences

Health; culture; tourism; education, vocational training, youth and SPORT

EU competences to support, coordinate and supplement.

## **Erasmus+: Sport**

- <u>First-time</u> funding for sport and physical activity projects
- Duration: 7 years (2014-2020)
- Total budget for Sport: EUR 265.9 mln
- Budget for 2018: EUR 37.4 mln
- Current 2018 call:

   Deadline 5 April 2018
   Results midsummer
